



## **Possible Vaccine Reactions**

Since the advent of vaccinations we have been able to protect ourselves and our pets against many diseases. Vaccinations help our pets to live longer, healthier lives. We will discuss your pet's lifestyle with you and recommend the vaccinations that are right for him/her.

Although vaccines are very safe, there are some possible reactions which you should watch for in your pet. These reactions are very rare but can occur. They may occur anywhere from a few minutes to about 24 hours after vaccination.

### **Reactions to report to us the next time you talk with us:**

- Slightly more quiet than normal
- Doesn't eat as much as usual
- Slight tenderness at the site of the vaccine
- A lump at the site of the vaccine.

### **Reactions to call us about:**

- One episode of vomiting or diarrhea
- Loss of appetite for more than 24 hours.
- A lump that isn't going away after a few days.

### **When to seek immediate attention:**

- Collapse
- Difficulty breathing
- Swollen face and or head
- Hives
- Multiple episodes of vomiting and diarrhea
- Severe pain at the injection site
